Intercept 5 Recommendations

- Incentivize landlords
 - o Risk Mitigation fund to open up more units
- People to walk beside those who have been recently incarcerated
 - Invest in case managers to reduce case loads
- Court-mandated rehabilitation program
 - o But none for psychiatric rehabilitation
 - Treatment and stabilized instead of being sent to jail
- Gap in services from release to treatment
 - o Released and get appointment but there is no follow-up
- Create a stable, reliable revenue stream that isn't a one-time infusion of support
- Create a rental task force including Glick Rentals
- Housing voucher for those incarcerated.
- Rapid rehousing and Beacon
- Fees
- Day Reporting and employer supports
