Position Summary:	<p>Incumbent serves as Harm Reduction Specialist for the health department and is responsible for the coordination, planning, and implementation of harm reduction services and education related to substance use and HIV/HCV prevention. Duties include providing HIV/HCV testing, engaging, and educating SSP participants on harm reduction strategies, performing intervention, establishing risk levels, and determining interest in treatment. They participate in planning, developing, and implementing community education on harm reduction strategies, including social media and community events. They distribute naloxone education and kits per state law and ISDH guidelines and they perform data entry of testing and SSP program data into appropriate databases.</p> <p><i>This is a grant position and requires the ability to monitor grant requirements.</i></p>
