

Ordinance 2019-33

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Council received a sworn affidavit from the Monroe County Recorder (“Recorder”), pursuant to Indiana Code 36-2-7-10.2(b), in order that the Recorder may pay office expenses of the Recorder’s Office from the Recorder’s Perpetuation Fund for budget year 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Council wishes to approve the Recorder’s annual request, made pursuant to the sworn affidavit, so that funds from the Recorder’s Perpetuation Fund may be used for certain office expenses, as requested by the Recorder.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Monroe County Council pursuant to Indiana Code 36-2-7-10(c) that the request made by the Monroe County Recorder to use funds from the Recorder’s Perpetuation Fund to pay office expenses as indicated in the Recorder’s sworn affidavit is approved. This Ordinance shall also serve as the Council’s approval of sufficient money from the Recorder’s Perpetuation Fund to cover any specific requests made by the Recorder.

SWORN STATEMENT OF ERIC SCHMITZ, MONROE COUNTY RECORDER

Eric Schmitz, the duly elected Monroe County Recorder, submits his sworn statement to the Monroe County Council pursuant to I.C. § 36-2-7-10.2(b) in order that the Monroe County Recorder may pay a portion of the expenses of the Monroe County Recorder's Office for calendar year 2020 from the Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund established under I.C. § 36-2-7-10(d). Under penalties for perjury and under oath, Eric Schmitz, Monroe County Recorder, states as follows:

- (A) The current revenue to the fund is sufficient to fulfill the statutory purpose of the fund;
- (B) The technology of the county recorder's office is presently updated and at a level to sufficiently meet the statutory purposes of the fund and the county recorder's office;
- (C) The fund has a sufficient reserve, consistent with the recorder's plan, to capitalize the next technology or other records management upgrade necessary to fulfill the statutory purpose of the fund and the county recorder's office; and
- (D) The county recorder specifically requests that all or a specific, identifiable portion of the fund be used to pay the expenses of the county recorder's office not related to full-time payroll for the following calendar year, according to the budget compiled by this office.

I, Eric Schmitz, affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that the foregoing representations are true.
