Position Summary:	This position is responsible for inspecting retail food establishments and seasonal/temporary events. Other responsibilities include performing plan reviews for potential new facilities, responding to complaints, and investigating complaints, including foodborne illnesses. Advises, educates, and instructs proprietors in rules, regulations, and proper procedures and practices concerning food sanitation to ensure compliance with regulations. Conducts follow-up investigations as individual cases require and takes action as appropriate. Completes cross training to assist in other areas of environmental health. The ideal candidate works well in a teambased environment, and has knowledge of federal, state, and local food codes. A typical day may include 1-2 hours of office time including consultations, filing and data entry plus 5-6 hours spent conducting inspections of retail food establishments. Required to serve as an emergency responder for public health events.
